



**MINUTES OF THE
CITY OF FRONTENAC
BOARD OF ALDERMEN
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2009
PUBLIC HEARING**

1. AGENDA ITEMS:

A public hearing regarding licensing for ambulance services within the City of Frontenac, Missouri.

Chief Trout stated the City is required to hold a public hearing for the ambulance license. Ms. Ross stated the hearing was published 15 days ago in the St. Louis Countian and that meets the requirement for the public hearing. The information was also posted on the City's website. Chief Trout stated this ambulance would be licensed by the Missouri Department of Emergency Medical Services under public safety. A resolution is proposed on the Board of Aldermen's regular meeting agenda which will be held following this hearing.
