The City of Frontenac reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any non-material deficiencies in a bid. Price will not be the only factor in the selection of the winning bidder. The City of Frontenac will award the bid to the bidder that is deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

All bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the name of the bidder, bidder's address and telephone number, and the words, "Bid Documents".

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and all blank spaces for bid prices must be completed in ink or typewritten in both words and figures.

Bids may be withdrawn personally or in writing provided that the withdrawal is received by the City of Frontenac prior to the time and date fixed for the bid opening. Bids may not be withdrawn after the bid opening.

Bidders may choose to inspect the vehicle for sale before preparing a bid.

The successful bidder shall provide payment for purchased vehicle in the form of a bank check or money order.

The City of Frontenac will award the bid to the bidder which the City in its sole discretion best meets the requirements of the Invitation to Bid and is in the best interest of the City.

The City of Frontenac reserves the right to reject or accept any or all bids in whole or in part; and to waive any non-material deficiencies in a bid if the City determines in its sole judgment that it is in the best interest of the City.
