## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT PLAN RELATING TO THE SITE OF THE FORMER SHRINERS HOSPITALS FOR CHILDREN

Mr. Mark Grimm of Gilmore and Bell was present. He stated this hearing is being held pursuant to Chapter 353 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, and the City's Ordinance No. 2017-1819 to consider a proposed development plan (the "Development Plan") for the site of the former Shriners Hospitals for Children located at 2001 South Lindbergh Boulevard in the City (the "Redevelopment Area").

Mr. Grimm stated this hearing is for the tax impact and financial impact of the taxing districts. All taxing districts were mailed certified notices. He said it is for a 50% tax abatement of the property.
