TO CONSIDER A PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF A COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ACT, SECTIONS 67.1401 TO 67.1571 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI, AS AMENDED.

Mr. Mark Grimm of Gilmore Bell stated the petition is for the creation of a community improvement district as a separate taxing district. The name will be Lind-Litz Community Improvement District.
