

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS TUESDAY, JULY 17, 2018 PUBLIC HEARING

The July 17, 2018, public hearing of the City of Frontenac was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Margot Martin presiding. The Alderpersons present were David Bray, Nalini Mahadevan, Brian Warner, and Tom O'Brien. Alderpersons Jamie Griesedieck and, Dan Kemper were absent.

Also in attendance were City Administrator, Jaysen Christensen; City Clerk, Leesa Ross; City Attorney, Kevin O'Keefe; Chief of Police, Tom Becker; Fire Chief, Jack Trout; Public Works Director, Jeff Wappelhorst; Building Commissioner, John Morgan and Finance Officer, Lea Ann Bennett.

Mayor Martin called the public hearing to order.

1. Review a request of a conditional use permit to allow the Harper School – Frontenac, LLC to operate at 11155 Clayton Road, Faith Des Peres Presbyterian Church.

Mr. Wagner the founder of the Harper School stated he was before the Board of Alderpersons for a request for a conditional use permit to open a school at the Faith Des Peres Presbyterian Church. He stated he did go before the Planning & Zoning Commission in June and received approved. He stated he has also spoken to several neighbors next to the church. He stated he hopes to open a pre-school and small elementary school. He will apply for a State license for a pre-school and hopes to open on September 4. He said his first year he expects a few classes of pre-school children, and he hopes to add additional classes moving forward.

Mr. Wagner stated he will apply for a permit for a new fence and a permit for a sign.

Mayor Martin asked if there were any questions from the audience members. There were none.
