PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION WEDNESDAY, MARCH 12, 2025

A. CALL TO ORDER

The March 12, 2025 meeting for the Public Works Commission of the City of Frontenac was called to order at 5:30 pm.

C. VOTE TO APPROVE AGENDA:

Chairman Newton requested approval of the March 12, 2025 agenda.

MOTION: Mr. Christofferson motioned and Alderperson Kilker seconded approval of the agenda. All voting members present voted in the affirmative. **MOTION PASSED.**

D. VOTE TO APPROVE MINUTES:

Chairman Newton requested approval of the November 13, 2024 minutes.

<u>MOTION</u>: Mr. Christofferson motioned and Alderperson Kilker seconded approval of the December 11, 2024 minutes. All voting members present voted in the affirmative. <u>MOTION PASSED</u>.

E. ADMINISTRATOR'S ADDRESS:

No comments were made at this time.

F. OLD BUSINESS:

1) Project Updates:

a. Geyer Road Phases:

- 1. Phase 1: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that construction is ongoing. We have been consulting with PCX Construction to aid in the progression. The Lochmueller Construction inspection team is providing oversight and assisting in locating utility conflicts.
- 2. Phases 2 & 3: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that the plat and legal descriptions are completed, and he has had one meeting with a homeowner and two are scheduled for this Friday. The Lochmueller Group will be calling to set appointments with property owners that the plan calls for additional working room and easements. Mr. Wappelhorst stated it is still too early to tell when this phase will start.

b. Spoede Bridge:

Mr. Wappelhorst stated Missouri American Water has started the process of completing the water main relocation but is having weather delays. They are sanitizing and tightening up the line and will go live soon. This is on Spire's to-do list this summer.

c. MoDOT:

Lindbergh Bridge over Deer Creek: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that this project is on track for the deck replacement of the bridge to start this summer, 2025. Follow-up meetings for right-of-way access are being scheduled by the right-of-way team.

d. Countryside Storm Water Project:

Mr. Wappelhorst stated the project has had five truckloads of sod going in, finish grading, and raingardens. They are knocking on doors to do sprinkler checks.

e. North & West Geyer Road Stormwater Project:

EDM is compiling residents' and trustees' concerns and putting together a plan.

f. East-West Gateway Council of Government / MoDOT:

Mr. Wappelhorst stated the City was notified of a TIP Grant Application for an upcoming project. The City has submitted the application with the application fees and the assistance of Lochmueller Group for the Clayton Road Sidewalk & Stormwater improvements from Geyer Rd. to Bopp Rd. The application was delivered by the deadline of February 7, 2025.
