

## City of Frontenac COVID-19 Updates

The City of Frontenac is monitoring the COVID-19 outbreak as it develops and is taking precautions for the safety of our city staff and citizens. As the public health situation continues to evolve, you can find up-to-date information regarding city policies and services below:

### *Building Permits and Inspections*

The public counter at City Hall is currently closed; however, applications and permits may still be dropped off and picked up in the City Hall lobby. Please call City Hall at (314) 994-3200 with questions or see the “COVID-19 Building Department Notice” on the City’s homepage under “Recent News”.

### *Trash Collection*

Gateway Disposal has temporarily suspended the collection of special bulky item pickups (e.g. mattresses, furniture, etc.). Trash, recycle, and yard-waste pick-up remains unchanged from the regular schedule and procedures.

### *Public Meetings*

Public meetings are currently being held via video and/or teleconference. Citizens are invited to join these meetings. Information about how to join a public meeting video conference or teleconference will be clearly noted at the top of each meeting agenda and will be posted on the City’s website in addition to being emailed to residents and posted on the public notice board in the City Hall lobby. The deadline for filing an annual business license has been changed from April 15 to July 15 in conjunction with the change to the federal income tax deadline.

### *Municipal Election*

The Tuesday, April 7, Municipal Election has been rescheduled to Tuesday, June 2 in accordance with the executive order from Governor Parson.

### *Municipal Court*

All municipal court proceedings throughout St. Louis County are suspended until at least April 17, 2020 by administrative order of the St. Louis County Presiding Judge.

### *Police and Fire/EMS*

The City’s 9-1-1 dispatching, police and fire/EMS services remain fully operational 24/7.
