

PUBLIC HEARING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS MONDAY, MAY 18, 2020, 5:00 P.M.

In light of the current public health crisis and the Federal, State and County Emergency Declarations, and in accord with the provisions of Sec. 610.020, RSMo., the City recognizes that it would be dangerous and impractical, if not impossible, for meetings to be physically accessible to the public. In order to balance both the need for continuity of government and protection of the health and safety of our residents, business persons and employees, this public hearing will not be open to public attendance in person. Instructions for providing public comments:

Persons interested in making their views known may phone into the meeting and make public comments at points during the meeting designated by the meeting chairperson, similar to if the meeting were being held in person.

The City of Frontenac, MO will hold a public hearing to address the allocation of \$20,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds which will become available on January 1, 2021. The public hearing will be held at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 18, 2020.
