## F. MAYOR'S ADDRESS:

G. OLD BUSINESS:

1) Project Updates:
a. Steeplechase Clayton Road Project: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that construction is completed. We are awaiting cost share from MSD and plantings are going in.
b. Timber Trail: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that project documents for the meeting with property owners are nearly ready to schedule.
c. Countryside Stormwater Project: Mr. Wappelhorst stated that we are continuing meetings with the first round of about 40 residents to talk with and we have 10- more homes with overland flow issues to meet with.

## H. NEW BUSINESS:

Scott Smith of Lochmueller Group thanked the members for their time tonight. He stated that the federal reimbursed process for the reconstruction of Geyer Road entails a three-phase project.

Mr. Lome Jackson of Lochmueller Group stated that Phase 1 of the project covers the north section of Geyer Road from Clayton down to Steeplechase as well as some new sidewalk on Clayton Rd.

Mr. J ackson stated that some properties alrea dy have easements
Mr.Jackson stated that the first majorfeature we get to are at GeyerDowns Lane where we need to tie into the MSD trunk line and up to existing struc tures with stom sewers. He sta ted that the removal of existing irigation systems, mailboxes, and entrance signage will take place where needed. The existing entrance monument will have to be removed and retumed/replaced beyond easements. Mr. Jackson stated that during
right-of-way (ROW) negotiations, it will be up to that owner/entity to replace structures in the correct placement.

Mr. Wappelhorst stated that the entrance of the West Geyer crosswalk section will see some changes to redirect water. Mr. Jackson stated that existing pavement will be covered with new concrete and gutteredges.

Mr. J ackson stated that there will be relocations of some utilities and existing mailboxes. Sidewalks will be against the c urb, and mailboxes will be parallel to the curb and not impact the sidewalk. Mr. J ackson stated the best-case scenarios for construction will be to start in late Summer to early fall. For property acquisitions, $90 \%$ go great, and $10 \%$ take a little longer. Once the first phase of Geyer is completed, phases II and III are expected to go a little easier after seeing the development.
