

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS SPECIAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 14, 2021, 6:00 P.M. VIA VIDEO CONFERENCE

The September 14, 2021, special meeting of the Board of Alderpersons of the City of Frontenac was called to order at 6:05 p.m., by Mayor Kate Hatfield. The Board of Alderpersons present were Dan Kemper, Nalini Mahadevan, Dan Millman, and Tom O'Brien.

Also, in attendance was City Administrator, Jaysen Christensen and City Attorney, Kevin O'Keefe.

A. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Hatfield called the meeting to order.

B. **NEW BUSINESS:**

Discussion of employee COVID policies.

Mayor Hatfield summarized weekly testing requirements for unvaccinated employees that have been considered in consultation with the City's legal counsel. There was a consensus among the aldermen present that the City should require unvaccinated employees to be tested for COVID weekly.

C. ADJOURNMENT

Alderman Millman motioned to adjourn the regular meeting and convene in executive session for the purpose of discussing legal matters. Alderman Kemper seconded the motion.
