

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC BOARD OF ALDERPERSON DECEMBER 20, 2022

The December 20, 2022 regular meeting of the Board of Alderpersons of the City of Frontenac was called to order at 6:03 p.m. with Kate Hatfield, presiding. The Alderpersons present were Pat Kilker, Jamie Griesedieck, Tom O'Brien, and Dan Millman. Alderperson Mahadevan was absent.

G. CITY STAFF'S REPORT

City Clerk

Ms. Ross stated election filing continues until Tuesday, December 27 at 5:00 p.m. At this time, we only have filings for the Mayor position and Alderperson Ward III.

2. Finance Officer

Ms. Bennett gave an update on revenue, expenses and sales taxes, which are 42% over budget for the year.

3. City Administrator

Mr. Christensen stated the comp plan is nearing completion and there will be a joint meeting of the Planning & Zoning Commission and Board of Alderpersons, on Tuesday, January 17 at 5:00 p.m., which will be followed by the regular board meeting. He also stated the February meeting will need to be moved as it coincides with the municipal league's legislative conference. The alternate dates were Monday, February 27 or Tuesday, February 28. The consensus was to have it on Tuesday, February 28, and if there is a Planning & Zoning Commission meeting, to push the time back to 7:00 p.m.

J. NEW BUSINESS:

1. <u>Bill No. 2022-2048</u>: An ordinance repealing Sections 210.010, 210.020, 210.030, 210.040, 210.050 and 210.060 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Frontenac, Missouri, relating to the Frontenac Fire Prevention and Protection Regulations and establishing the International Fire Code as the fire protection code for the City of Frontenac.

Asst. Chief Halloran stated this will update the fire codes, which is an ISO requirement. He stated moving forward, they hope to update the codes every three years. He stated the biggest change to the code has to do with rooftop bars. He stated after it is passed the city will comply and be ready for the ISO review in 2023.

Mayor Hatfield asked for a motion for a second reading.

<u>MOTION:</u> Alderperson Millman made a motion and Alderperson O'Brien made a second to the motion to approve a second reading of Bill No. 2022-2048. All alderpersons presented voted "Aye". The vote was unanimous. **MOTION PASSED.**

2. <u>Bill No. 2022-2049</u>: An ordinance levying an additional sales tax on sales of adult use marijuana and calling an election for voter approval of such tax.

Mr. O'Keefe stated this language is for a 3% tax on recreational marijuana, which was a state constitutional amendment, passed by the voters on November 8. This bill will allow the city to levy a tax to collect an extra 3% on the sale of recreational marijuana.

Mayor Hatfield asked for a motion for a second reading.

<u>MOTION:</u> Alderperson Griesedieck made a motion and Alderperson Millman made a second to the motion to approve a second reading of Bill No. 2022-2049. All alderpersons presented voted "Aye". The vote was unanimous. <u>MOTION PASSED.</u>

Mayor Hatfield asked Ms. Ross for a second reading of Bill No. 2022-2049.

<u>Bill No. 2022-2049</u>: An ordinance levying an additional sales tax on sales of adult use marijuana and calling an election for voter approval of said tax.

Mayor Hatfield asked for a motion to approve Bill No. 2022-2049.
