A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A 5-YEAR SOLE SOURCE AGREEMENT WITH FLOCK SAFETY FOR AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 Capital Improvement Fund includes an appropriation of \$16,000 for renewal of license plate reader technology; and

WHEREAS, Flock license plate reader cameras are utilized across the St. Louis region by numerous police agencies to enhance surveillance coverage and improve community safety; and

WHEREAS, the Frontenac Police Department currently has four (4) license plate reader cameras positioned throughout the city and recognizes the need to expand its inventory by one (1) additional camera to enhance its surveillance coverage; and

WHEREAS, Flock Safety has provided an option to enter into a 5-year lease that would maintain current annual pricing of \$2,500 per camera for the entirety of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Frontenac wishes to capitalize on savings by extending the Flock Safety agreement an additional five-year period in lieu of a one-year renewal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS THAT,

The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a 5-year capital lease agreement with Flock Safety for usage of five (5) license plate reader cameras. The initial cost for the first year shall not exceed \$13,150.00, including installation. Such authorization shall be extended for the remainder of the four-year period, ending in 2028, with an annual subscription cost not to exceed \$12,500.
