



**MINUTES OF THE
CITY OF FRONTENAC
BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2019
PUBLIC HEARING**

The Tuesday, November 19, 2019, public hearing of the City of Frontenac was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Kate Hatfield presiding. The Alderpersons present were Dan Millman, Brian Warner, Dan Kemper, and Tom O'Brien. Alderpersons Nalini Mahadevan and Jamie Griesedieck were not present.

Also, in attendance were City Administrator, Jaysen Christensen; City Clerk, Leesa Ross; City Attorney, Kevin O'Keefe; Fire Chief, Marc Ulses; Chief of Police, Mark Guttmann; Public Works Director, Jeff Wappelhorst; Building Commissioner, John Morgan; and Finance Officer, Lea Ann Bennett.

Mayor Hatfield called the public hearing to order.

1. Request to operate an in-house tutoring business at 10356 Gold Dust Avenue.

Mr. Andy Crossett and Ms. Erika Crossett the applicants discussed their plan to have an in-house tutoring business for children with learning disabilities in their home. Mr. Crossett requested some changes to the proposed bill and passed out a proposal with the changes.

There were questions from the Board of Alderpersons. Mr. Morgan also answered questions.

Mr. Michael Long of Gold Dust spoke favorably about the proposal.

Ms. Hannah Mayer spoke about the impact the tutoring sessions made with her daughters.

Ms. Carmen Eden of Gold Dust stated she had concerns about the traffic with additional cars coming to the house, as the street is a dead-in street.

Mr. Christensen stated both Ward II Alderpersons, Alderperson Mahadevan and Alderperson Griesedieck were unable to attend the meeting tonight and neither of them had any objects to the proposal.
